Legend and Explanation:

Prog: This column gives you the wagreing number for each horse. This is usually the post position number as well, but not always.

M/L: This is the "Morning Line" odds. This is an estimate of the probable odds as determined by the track handicapper.

Points: The point total is determined from literally thousands of calculations by our proprietary software. This is a numerical rating of each horse in the race, where a higher rating is better.

Pre: Our "Predictability Index" is not a rating of the horse, but rather a rating of the data available and it's usefulness in assessing the rating for each horse., A higher number simply means we had better more reliable data. A "100" PRE is a "Best Bet" and provide a high win rate for our customers.

Mud: This indicates when a horse has shown an inclination to perform well on tracks not rated fast or good.

Q: This indicates a horse whose last charted race was a "qualifying" race and not always a clear indication of true ability.

X: A horse with an "X" here has broken stride in its previous race (not caused by interference).

I: An "I" here indicates a horse that was bothered (interfered with) in its previous start.

>21: Indicates a horse that has not raced in at lease 3 weeks. A possible red flag for harness horses.

Form: A numerical rating that measures the horse's recent finishes. A higher number is better (more wins, 2nds, 3rds, etc.)

Class: A numerical rating of the caliber of competition this horse has raced against recently (with a minimum basic degree of success).

Fav: This horse was the wagering "favorite" in its most recent race, but failed to win!

Speed: We provide an adjusted speed rating for each horse. Using some very complex statistical analyses, we take into account the daily track variant, track condition, and track-to-track speed variant, to determine the true adjusted speed for each horse. The resulting value represents the projected "mile" time for each horse at today's track.

Driver Points: Each driver is rated based on his/her stats at today's track, and at all tracks. Then we look at the track stats to determine just how important the driver rating is at this track and arrive at a numerical rating for each driver on today's race card. The same driver at a different track will probably have a different rating.

At the top of the Report: We not only give you the best statistical analysis of each horse and each race, but we take it a step further. We tell you how well we have done recently at each track. This section gives you a straight win percent over the last week, and also the last month. Comparing these two numbers will let you know if there is a trend developing that you need to be aware of.

Likewise we give you the success stats on other wager types. Pay particular attention to our "Place" percentages (top picks 1st or 2nd) because this tells you how powerful our top picks are as keys in your exactas, and trifectas.

You might also see "ROI" on the top section and this means that our top picks have generated a raw profit on win bets (betting all races over the period). Naturally as an experienced bettor you will be able to improve on our overall win profit since some races just do not offer good value, or a reasonably predictable outcome. By avoiding some races you will be able to use our powerful stats to gain the "Winner's Edge" at the races!
